AN ACT TO AMEND THE STATISTICS ACT 1993, IN
RELATION TO THE FIRST CENSUS OF POPULATION
OF IRELAND TAKEN SINCE THE ESTABLISHMENT OF
10 THE STATE; TO AFFORD THAT CENSUS A SPECIAL
HERITAGE STATUS AND TO HAVE SUCH RELEASED
TO THE PUBLIC FOR GENEALOGICAL, HISTORICAL
AND OTHER RESEARCH.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE OIREACHTAS AS FOLLOWS:

1. — This Act may be cited as the Statistics (Heritage Amendment) Short Title.

2. — “1911 Census” means the last census of population taken by Interpretation.
the United Kingdom authorities for the entire island of Ireland.

“1926 Census” means the first census of population taken by
Saorstát Éireann.

20 3. — Section 35 of the Statistics Act 1993 is amended by inserting Amendment.
“and in the case of the 1926 Census of population due to its import-
ance as the first Census taken since 1911 and the first taken since
the establishment of the State and in recognition, therefore, of its
special heritage significance this Act shall cease to apply to that
25 Census” after “the date of the relevant Census”.
