Dear Mr. McEnery

I am directed by the Commissioner to refer to your correspondence of 26 September 2012 in regard to the allowances payable within An Garda Síochána and provide the following by way of response.

The request for all allowances in An Garda Síochána for which a business case has been submitted and which subsequently appeared on the website of the Department of Public Expenditure & Reform was made under seven individual headings which are as follows:

1. The title of the Allowance.
2. The number of current recipients.
3. The cost of the Allowance in 2011.
4. The range of payments made in respect of this allowance in 2011.
5. The date the payment of this allowance commenced.
6. When the rate last changed.
7. Whether it will be paid to new recruits or in respect of new appointments.

The response to heading 1,2,4,5 & 6 are contained in Tab A.

The number of recipients figures were extrapolated from those supplied by Financial Shared Services, Killarney and are correct as at 4 October 2012 or pay-week no. 40 of the year.

Many of the allowances listed pre-date the Garda Commissioner becoming the Accounting Officer for the organisation and therefore commencement dates are unknown. However many of these allowances commenced or were prompted by individual Agreed

Reports, so where the actual date is unknown, reference is made to the signing of an Agreed Report.

The changes in these rates were prompted by variations brought about by agreed reports or by way of general government directive.

Heading 3 – The cost of allowances in 2011 is provided in Tab B


In relation to Heading 7 ‘Whether it will be paid to new recruits or in respect of new appointments’ - The Minister for Public Expenditure and Reform, Brendan Howlin, T.D. published the outcome of the review of public service allowances and premium pay following consideration by Government on 18 September 2012.

The Minister announced that arising from the review changes will be made to the public service allowance regime. In respect of An Garda Síochána, there are a number of allowances specifically applicable to the organisation, in addition to those allowances which were described as ‘Cross – Sectoral’.

In a letter dated 19 September 2012, from Mr Colin Menton, Department of Public Expenditure & Reform, reference is made to ‘further letters will issue to you shortly regarding common civil service allowances and allowances specific to your Department /Office.’ At the time of this report, this further communication has not been received.

The remaining issue to be clarified therefore is what is meant by ‘new beneficiaries’ as opposed to ‘new entrant’. Until this clarification is received heading 7 cannot be fully answered.
