Dear Sir,

I have not, to date, received any communication from the Public Accounts Committee although I have heard numerous reports, including reports from broadcast interviews with members of PAC, that I had received a direct invitation from the PAC. You can communicate with me at my email address above and at my home address which is [REDACTED].

From media reports it would appear that a substantial impasse has arisen between myself and the PAC. I am anxious to address and disabuse this misconception and to this end would respectfully request that the PAC communicate directly and expeditiously with me so that we can cooperate in this endeavour.
